### TO APPLY, FOLLOW THESE STEPS:

- Read the Terms and Conditions on the back of this form to ensure you qualify for the rebate. To be eligible for a washer rebate, your home must use electricity for either the dryer or water heater.

- Purchase your new appliance(s) by December 31, 2019.
- Complete and sign the rebate form and attach a copy of your itemized receipt(s).

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### Please refer to the following terms and conditions prior to signing acceptance:

The following rebates are available for applications that meet the terms and conditions listed below:

#### CLOTHES DRYER

- A \$50 rebate is available for electric dryer models certified by ENERGY STAR®.
- A \$100 rebate is available for select electric dryers with hybrid heat pump technology (using resistance heat and a heat pump).
- A \$200 rebate is available for select electric dryers with heat pump technology (using only a heat pump).

#### CLOTHES WASHER

- Customer must use electricity for either clothes dryer or water heat at a minimum for eligibility.
- A \$50 rebate is available for select ENERGY STAR® certified models. Note, some top load models do not qualify.

- Appliance(s) must be a qualified model. A list of qualified models and rebate amounts may be found at [seattle.gov/appliances](http://seattle.gov/appliances). Seattle City Light stickers are applied to qualifying models at most local retailers.
- This rebate is valid for purchases made by December 31, 2019.
- This rebate application must be emailed or postmarked within 90 days of the installed equipment purchase date(s).
- Prior to submission of this rebate form products must be installed and functional.
- Limit one rebate per account for each appliance type. Washer and dryer rebates may be applied for at separate times.
- Your appliance(s) must be installed at an address in the Seattle City Light service area. Commercial and residential customers are eligible to apply for qualified, residential-style appliances.
- Customers are required to provide the Seattle City Light account number for the address where the appliance is being installed. Landlords are not required to provide an account number. Applications without an account number may be denied if SCL cannot verify applicant as a customer or property owner.
- All information must be complete, and a copy of an itemized receipt(s) included to be considered for payment. Receipt(s) must include retailer name, address, phone number, purchase date and price, and product make and model.
- It is Seattle City Light's (SCL) intent to mail the appropriate rebate check within sixty days or SCL's receipt of a completed application. Lack of documentation or information from the Program Participant to SCL will delay rebate processing.
- This rebate form and program documentation is subject to Washington's Public Records Act, RCW Chapter 42.56.

By submitting this rebate form Program Participants recognize that prior to payment Seattle City Light (SCL) may contact the applicant, related vendor or installer to evaluate installation information, inspect the installed product(s) listed on this form, and request the Program Participant to submit supporting documentation. SCL will review the project to determine eligibility and qualification for a rebate in accordance with these terms and conditions. This program is completely voluntary, and Program Participant assumes any risks of injury, property damage, and expenses that may arise during the implementation of these energy conservation measures.

SCL does not make any representations, promises, or warranties for any efficiencies of potential energy savings, installed products, materials, equipment fitness, labor required, or merchantability for any purpose. Program Participant represents and warrants that all installed requirements are in compliance with all applicable federal, state and local laws, codes, ordinances, including all building energy and accessibility codes and in compliance with these terms and conditions.
