## TERMS & CONDITIONS

### Please refer to the following terms and conditions prior to signing acceptance on reverse side:

- You must be a customer of Seattle City Light and the installation address is in the Seattle City Light service area. Existing single family residences (1-4 units) that are at least 1 year old qualify. Multifamily units do not qualify.
- This form must be postmarked within 90 days of the installation date.
- Your current primary heating source for the home is electric resistance zonal heat or electric forced air furnace. Examples: electric resistance baseboards, Cadet or King wall heaters, hydronic baseboard heaters, or space heaters. [NOTE: homes with gas furnaces or oil heat, are not eligible.]
- The installed heat pump system must meet the following qualifications:
  - Equipment needs to employ an inverter-driven outdoor compressor, with inverter-driven or variable-speed indoor blowers and use R410A refrigerant; must meet a minimum HSPF rating of 9.0 or higher for single-zone systems, or 8.5 or higher for multi-zone systems.
  - Equipment must be installed per manufacturer's specifications by a participating Program Contractor (for a list of contractors, visit [seattle.gov](http://seattle.gov)).
- Home Heating Rebate Form, Contractor Installation Form, and all supporting documents must be provided before Seattle City Light can issue a rebate. All forms may be downloaded at [seattle.gov](http://seattle.gov).
- DHP upgrade to a new efficient model must have a minimum 11.0 HSPF.

Seattle City Light ("SCL") will review the Owner or Authorized Personnel's ("Owner") rebate request application ("Request") and determine whether the installed Heat Pump products qualify for the rebate. If the installed HP products qualify, SCL will mail the appropriate rebate within sixty (60) days of SCL's receipt of the Request. Only one rebate is available per home. By signing this Request and accepting any rebate, Owner (1) represents and warrants that Owner has installed all Heat Pump products in compliance with all applicable federal, state and local laws, codes, ordinances, including all building energy and accessibility codes and in compliance with the procedures specified by SCL for the Heat Pump Program; and (2) acknowledges and agrees that: (a) SCL has not and does not make any representations or promises with respect to the Heat Pump products, the energy consumption, and/or energy savings from the installed heat pump products; and (b) that SCL MAKES NO IMPLIED OR EXPRESS WARRANTIES REGARDING THIS PROGRAM, ITS POLICIES, PROCEDURES, INSPECTIONS AND/OR ANY OWNER INSTALLED HEAT PUMP PRODUCTS, AND SPECIFICALLY DISCLAIMS ANY WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.
